## GEOGRAPHY TRIP TO TOBERMORY 2018

Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

Your son or daughter has a wonderful opportunity to visit and experience the Bruce Peninsula National Park in Tobermory, Ontario. The purpose of the trip is to give students a first hand look at the geographical phenomenon that we are studying this year in geography and learn about biodiversity and our First Nations peoples. This is also an opportunity for the grade nine students to develop community within their grade.

The trip will take place from Thursday, September 20 - Saturday, September 22, 2017. We will depart from the school on chartered buses at approximately 9:30 AM (with a pick up in Teviotdale at Wellington Construction at approximately 10:15 AM). **Students leaving from Woodland can come on their normal busses in the morning and proceed directly to the AUD** (if students are being driven to school they must arrive no later than 9:00am.) In accordance with Woodland policy all bags will be checked before boarding the bus. We will arrive back at the school on Saturday **at about 3:30pm, with a Teviotdale drop off at 2:30pm**. Students must make arrangements to be picked up at these times.

The students will be organizing themselves into groups of four-six and will be instructed to make their own arrangements for providing their tents, etc. The main meals for the trip are included with the trip and the school needs to be informed of any food allergies. The students may take some snacks along for themselves, though these snacks **MUST NOT** be kept in or eaten in any tents and will be stored in vehicles overnight. **Please be advised that the snacks have to be nut free.**

Teacher chaperones for the trip consist of Mr. Kooy, Mrs. Guetter, Mr. Stevens, Mrs. Bryson, & Ms. Verstraeten.
